INSTRUCTIONS TO PARENTS FOR ACADEMIC YEAR - 2021-2022

Dear Parents,

We are fully committed to providing the best education and environment for overall development of your children. Keeping this in mind and there are a few changes in the School's functioning for this academic year we'd like to inform you.

Keeping in mind the need for safety measures for the children within the campus we have implemented the following:

- Closed Circuit (CCTV) Surveillance in all classrooms, corridors and playground.
- Bearer ID cards for parents and one guardian. It is mandatory for parents and / or guardians to be in possession of a school bearer card when they come to pick up their ward. The person (Bearer) authorized to collect your ward from the school must show this card before collecting the child. In case of lost Bearer Cards, parents are requested to apply for the same at the school fee counter.
- Entry to school campus will be restricted to parents and the authorized guardian only. Visitors will not be permitted.
- Parents, guardians are not allowed to visit the classrooms during school hours. Any need to meet the teachers may be done during monthly parents-teachers' meetings only.
- Lunch and snacks are to be sent with the children when they are sent to the school in the morning. In case of delay, the lunch bag with the child's name and class clearly marked may be handed over to the support staff/Aaya at the gate.
- Vehicles are not permitted within the campus.
- Parents who pickup or drop the children to school are requested to note that the parking is not permitted in front of the gate to ensure the safety of all children.
- Taking a U-turn in front of the gate is strictly prohibited, to avoid huge traffic jam in front of the school gate making it a public woe.
- Bearer cards must be produced before entering the school gate during the school hours if you are collecting your child for any reason.
- All children must be dropped by 8:30 a.m. and picked up by 3:30 p.m. Parents are reminded to be in the school 5 minutes prior to the dispersal time.
- Uniforms should be purchased from the authorized vendor specified by the school to ensure texture and quality of fabric is maintained
- The diary has to be checked regularly and the notes must be acknowledged by the parent.
- Kindly ensure that all belongings of the child like books, stationery kit, water bottle, snack box, school bag are labeled with the name of the child, grade and section.
- Kindly make sure that the child carries a napkin, spoon/fork along with the lunch box.
- Kindly avoid sending any junk food like chips, wafers or chocolates for snack or for lunch.
- Apart from the PTM, parents can meet the teachers by seeking an appointment which will be scheduled by the principal subject to their availability, on week days between 3:30 p.m. and 4:30 p.m. on working days.
- Children will be allowed into the campus only after 8:15 a.m.

We trust you'll understand the need to implement these steps to ensure the safety of your children and to ensure peaceful and healthy academic atmosphere and extend your complete cooperation in making the campus a safer place.

INSTRUCTIONS TO STUDENTS FOR ACADEMIC YEAR 2021-2022

As we embark a new journey in this academic session, we would like you to remember a few general instructions which are listed below. These are school policies which, only with your cooperation, will help ensure discipline of the system.

- School Timings: LKG to X Std: 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. (Monday to Friday). Saturday 8:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. Saturday is an off day for KG classes.
- It is mandatory for students to attend the first and the last day of school (i.e., before and after every vacation). Refer to school calendar for vacation schedule.
- For any other day of absence, the parents should submit a written explanation in the diary.
- A late entry is marked for those come within 15 minutes from the bell timing. Any student, who comes after 15 minutes will be sent back.
- When a long term absence is anticipated, student must obtain a written permission from the Principal.
- Only in case of emergencies, the students will be permitted to leave early with the permission of the Principal and Parent/Guardian should submit a written request.
- Children, who are sick with any kind of illness, should not be sent to school until they have recovered completely.
- ID card is mandatory while in the campus
- Girls need to use only black colored rubber bands, clips and hair bands. Long hair must be tied neatly in two pony tails or plaits along with a hair band.
- Boys need to be well groomed. Fancy hairstyles/ haircuts will not be permitted.
 - Students must carry the school diary regularly
 - The first page of the diary needs to be filled without fail.
 - Toys, magazines, comics, mobile phones, electronic gadgets etc. are not permitted to school and in case confiscated will be returned only to the parent personally after a meeting with the principal.
- Homework is assigned on a daily basis and needs to be submitted as per the schedule mentioned in the diary.
- We sincerely solicit your co-operation in making this academic year a successful one.
